<p>TEACHERS</p>	<p><i>Teachers and staff have the RIGHT to</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be treated with dignity and respect • Work in a safe, supportive environment • Be involved in policy making, planning and school improvement • A consistent student management policy that supports teaching, learning and social interaction • Appropriate professional development 	<p><i>Teachers and staff have the RESPONSIBILITY to</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communicate respectfully and effectively with others • Provide quality learning opportunities for all students • Use effective, relevant and appropriate teaching strategies • Create a supportive classroom environment that promotes all childrens' self esteem • Promote children's understanding that they have a responsibility for their own learning and behaviour • Help children to understand that their actions and choices have consequences
