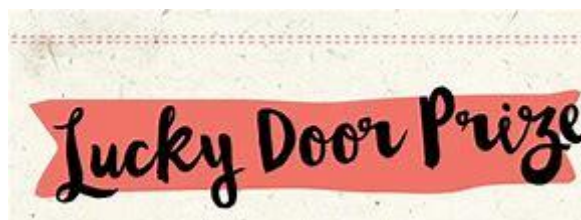
Dear Calwell Families,
