### Future of P&C outcome

Thank you to the families who attended the P&C special meeting last week. It was great to see some new faces eager to engage with other members of the school community to support our children's learning and school experience.

We had two positions on the future of the P&C – to continue or disband. It was clear very quickly that we were not going to be able to form a committee in 2018, which we are legally required to do to maintain our incorporated association status. We also discussed the financial implication of continuing the P&C as a separate entity. It was agreed that continuing to pay 20% of our hard earned fundraising income in fees and insurance was not a good financial strategy. The motion to dissolve the P&C was passed unanimously.

So what does this mean for the future of our P&C activities? The activities which are valued by our students and community, like Mother's Day/Father's Day stalls, Disco, End of year books, Craft club etc. will continue but will be co-ordinated by the school team with community volunteer support.

Our school team wants our community to be involved in decision making about activities, improving communication between the school and parents, and setting goals and strategies for community engagement.

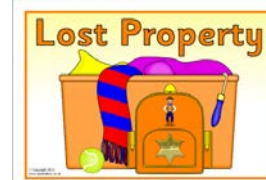
