Reconciliation Day

Our Monday public holiday is Reconciliation Day in the Australian Capital Territory and marks the beginning of National Reconciliation Week. The day gives people across Australia the opportunity to focus on reconciliation between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians.

On July 27, 1967, more than 90% of Australians voted in a referendum to amend the constitution which discriminated against Aborigines and Torres Strait Islanders. The outcome of the 1967 referendum constituted a resounding victory for civil rights in Australia—an event we now celebrate each year. Classes will be learning a little about Reconciliation Day as this is part of our country's history and included in the Australian Curriculum.

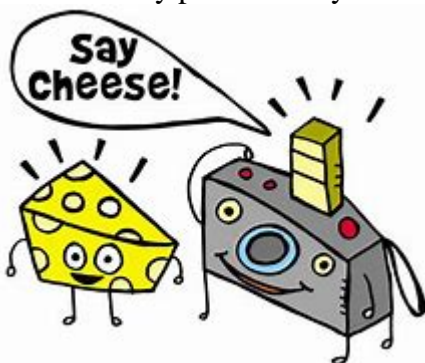
