Staff Professional Learning

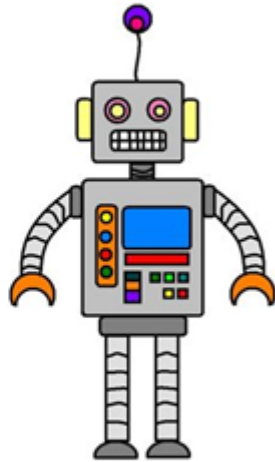
