From the Principal

Dear Calwell Families,

It was disappointing for all of us that the Year 3/4 and 5/6 camps had to be cancelled this year, however, yesterday Birrigai came to us! Enrolments

A friendly reminder to parents of Year 6 students that all students transitioning to year 7 in any public High School including Calwell High, must complete the online enrolment application. We are also now accepting the second-round enrolments for preschool 2021. Offers of a place to families who enrolled before 5pm 5 June will be sent a placement offer by the last week of July.

COVID19 Restrictions

The Education Directorate will be sending out information to schools soon about relaxations that can take place as of term 3. For the remainder of this term the restrictions we have in place will remain and changes for term 3 will be communicate as soon as they are available to us.

Car Park Safety

While there is still one of two issues during drop-off and pickup, overall things have been going very well, especially when staff are present to ensure drivers are adhering to the process. As our children's safety is everyone's responsibility, I can only urge parents/carers again not to be impatient and to make the extra 5 minutes needed to ensure all children are safe. **The biggest problem we are facing is the number of parents arriving well before 3pm. Students DO NOT leave their classrooms until just after 3pm. this means they will not reach the pick-up area until approx. 3.05pm.** The car park simply cannot accommodate a large number of cars waiting as this results in cars having to make numerous loops of the carpark and this is both frustrating and impacts on traffic on Downard St. **PLEASE, PLEASE follow the following guidelines:**

- **Arrive at or after 3pm.**
- **No parking** in the drop-off / pick-up zones
- Children in Year **1 & 2** are collected in the car park pick-up zone in the car park. Years 3-6 and those with siblings are collected at the front of the school.
- **Do not allow your child/ren to get in or out of the car until you have STOPPED along the front of the hall – that is beyond the stairs leading into the school foyer.**
- **ALWAYS** look out for pedestrians and stop at the zebra crossing

If everyone follows these guidelines, we have happy drivers (and staff) out of the carpark in under 15 minutes guaranteed!
