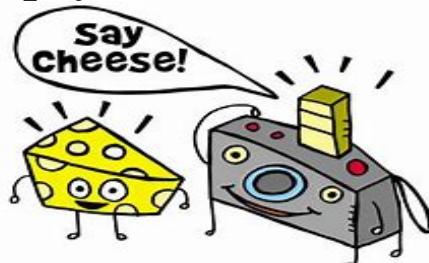
Mental Health Issues and Young People: FREE Parenting Forum
