Pick-up/Drop-off - Car Park

We are continuing to have some congestion in the car park which often leads to the blocking of Downard St. It appears that one of the main contributing factors to this situation is family members arriving too early to collect their child/ren and cars then being unable to keep moving through the car park. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 3.00 PM.** Classes are not dismissed until 3pm and it takes another five minutes for students to be at the front of the school or in the car park area ready to be picked-up. If you arrive before 3pm, please park in a car park as cars are **not permitted to park in the drop-off / pick-up zones.** Cars should also NOT park on the nature strip in front of the pedestrian crossing as this blocks the vision of other drivers and pedestrians. The system we have implemented is working well with all students being collect by no later than 3.15pm when all members of the community cooperate and adhere to the process. Please be respectful and mindful that it is not acceptable to abuse any staff member who is trying to clear the car park for the benefit of all.

SAS Onboarding Message for School Communities

On Monday 14 September, our school will progress into the third stage of implementation of the new School Administration System (SAS), the Enrolment module. So far, the program has helped to bring digital roll marking, parent / carer SMS communication and wellbeing processes across all ACT Public Schools. This is a major step for our school and the Directorate as we move away from the MAZE system as our source of student and financial information.

The Directorate's SAS team will be working very closely with us to ensure that the correct support processes are in place to ensure that the transition is a success.

As we transition into the new modules of the system over this period, information will be provided to the school community about new features that enhance or change current school processes. This update is particularly exciting for the administration of our school as previous releases have been focused on teacher use.

We expect this to be a smooth transition and appreciate your support and understanding during this time. As always you can contact the school office if you have any questions or concerns that may arise.

School Attendance

The new roll marking system in schools enables us to monitor when students arrive and leave school, as well as student absences. As mentioned above it also sends an SMS and provides the facility for parent/carers to notify the reason for an absence. We will be contacting parent/carers more regularly to bring to your attention if your child is frequently late to school or when your child has a number of absences. We understand that it is easy to be unaware of how much school your child has missed when absences are spread over the term. When a student misses a considerable period during a term, it can have a significant impact on their progress and social interactions with their peers. When children are repeatedly late to school, not only is their learning affected, they miss important information and instructions at the start of the day and the class routine is interrupted as the teacher's need to go over what has just been missed.

Kindergarten Health Check

Canberra Health Services is offering a targeted kindergarten health check concentrating on vision and hearing. These health checks are performed in clinics at the City Health Centre Mondays and Fridays and there will be appointments most days in the school holidays. An appointment can be made by phoning the Central Intake Line on 51249977.

Hats and Drink Bottles

We would like to remind families that all students need to bring a sun-smart hat and drink bottle to school. August brings back our 'No Hat, No Play' policy – students require a hat to play outside in the sun and participate in sport lessons. A reminder that our bubblers at school are not available due to COVID 19 and students require a drink bottle clearly labelled with their name.

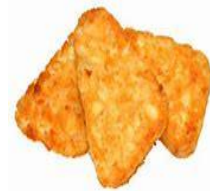
